



Health & Safety

The recreation ground tennis does not employ staff to undertake daily oversight of the courts, equipment and supervision of players and the Charsfield Recreation Ground Committee relies on permit holders and users of the facilities to identify any issues which may need to be addressed.

RISK ASSESSMENT

A regular risk assessment will be undertaken to ensure that the premises and equipment are safe and suitable for play.

At all times, permit holders should appraise the risk and satisfy themselves that the courts are safe and wear appropriate footwear with adequate grip.

GENERAL

Notices have been affixed to the notice board and courts asking that all permit holders check that the court is suitable for play. If there is a problem with the premises or equipment then permit holders are asked not to use them until the problem has been rectified and inform a member of the Committee as soon as possible in order that the problem can be rectified.

WHAT TO DO IN AN EMERGENCY

Permit holders and users of the recreation ground tennis's premises should note that there is no public telephone on the recreation ground tennis premises. They should therefore ensure that they have a means of contacting the emergency services should the need arise i.e. a mobile phone. Charsfield RG Tennis is an unmanned facility and it is therefore the individual responsibility of each permit holder to inform those you are playing with of any known medical condition that you have that may require immediate assistance.

Accident and Emergency Guidelines

- Stay calm but act swiftly and observe the situation. Is there any danger of further injuries?
- Listen to what the injured person is saying
- If the injury is minor, alert a first aider to take appropriate action
- If the injury requires specialist treatment, call the emergency services
- If the injury has occurred during a session with children, ensure the children are adequately supervised
- Do not move someone with major injuries – wait for the emergency services
- Contact the injured person's parent/carer (if appropriate)
- Sign the First Aid book to report all incidents and inform the tennis coordinator
