The Governance and Accountability Guide states that "In the special case where an authority receives an asset as a gift at zero cost, for example by transfer from a principal authority under a community asset transfer scheme, the asset should be included in the asset register with a nominal one pound  $(\pounds 1)$  value as a proxy for the zero cost.
